The Adelaide Brighton Cement Birkenhead Plant will be undergoing an annual maintenance shutdown from Sunday 7 January until Wednesday 31 January 2018. This is a scheduled event where some of our major production equipment is taken offline and undergoes maintenance and upgrades.

Adelaide Brighton Cement is investing significantly in equipment upgrades and other works. Some of the work being undertaken includes initiatives from our Environmental Improvement Plan and once completed will enable us to operate with improved environmental performance.

The majority of the maintenance work will be undertaken by local contractors and businesses. During the shutdown period we could have up to 300 contractors onsite, so Elder Road and connected roads will be busier than usual.

The supply of cement and cement products to Adelaide Brighton's customers will not be impacted by the shutdown period as previous production has ensured continuity of supply.

The Birkenhead Plant shutdown will provide a significant financial contribution to the South Australian economy, which benefits the Birkenhead community through employment and ongoing local investment.
