DOG FRIENDLY PARK SAFETY RULES

Adelaide Brighton Cement has provided the dog friendly park for the enjoyment of both dogs and people in our community since 2015

Please Do

- Keep walking - this will reduce territorial behaviour
- Stay alert and focused on your dog at all times
- Keep your dog under effective control of a handler at least 16 years of age and leave the park immediately if it becomes aggressive
- Be mindful of our local residents, please try to minimise excessive barking of dogs.
- Leave the park if your dog is continuously barking excessively
- Use Hargarve & Alfred street double gate entry to enter/exit park when other dogs are present
- Clean up after your dog – bins are provided
- Ensure all children are accompanied by a responsible adult

Please Don't

- Come into the park if your dog is unvaccinated, sick, aggressive or on heat
- Bring puppies that have not completed their vaccinations or under the age of four months
- Come into the enclosure if it is already crowded
- Bring in food and toys
- Bring in children without careful adult supervision
- Bring bikes, scooters & skateboards

Owners are legally responsible for the behaviour of their dogs at all times and use of the dog friendly park is at the dog owner's risk
